I. Other Information:

1. Candidates who wish to appear for the above can download the Application Form from the Website of ICMR-Vector Control Research Centre (www.vcrc.res.in). Candidates are requested to fill the application form and bring all original certificates of educational qualifications (Certificate/Statement of marks), experience certificates, Aadhaar Card, Community certificates (SC/ST/OBC) along with one set of Xerox of the same duly self-attested along with a recent passport size photograph for attending the Written Test / Interview. Persons belonging to Other Backward Category should bring the latest OBC (Non-creamy layer) Certificate issued by the respective Tahsildar/MRO specifically issued for the purpose of applying for Central Govt. posts.
2. Age, Qualifications, Experience etc. will be reckoned as on the date of Walk-in-Written Test/Interview.
3. Age relaxation is applicable to the post under reserved category, as per Govt. of India norms. Age concession to the extent of service rendered in other research projects will also be admissible for experienced and skilled persons.
4. Mere fulfilling the essential qualification does not guarantee for the selection.
5. Person already in regular time scale service under any Government Department/Organizations are not eligible to apply.
6. No TA/DA etc. will be paid to the candidates for appearing in walk-in- written test or interview.
